## **We're ready when you are!**

St Petroc's Society is a voluntary agency who works with single homeless people. We will endeavour to help you in a variety of different ways. However, we will not push you into anything, when you are ready for our help just ask.

### **What can we do for you?**

#### Support

You could get help with practical things such as blankets, food, clothing or simply a friendly face to talk to.

#### Advice

You can get advice on homelessness, accommodation and welfare benefits.

#### Information

You can obtain information on health issues, transport, other agencies, our services

### **What we cannot do**

The team does not carry any cash so please don't ask for money. We also cannot give you a lift to appointments.

### **How to contact us**

We receive referrals from all sorts of different people and when this happens they will come to find you. We work on the streets all the time and attend the local soup kitchens so you may just bump into us one day. You can walk into any CAB or housing department and ask them to contact us for you or you could give us a call direct using the numbers on the back of this leaflet. If you would prefer you could drop into one of the surgeries located around the county. Times of surgeries and soup kitchens are listed overleaf

### **What else does St Petroc's do?**

We operate a number of different services throughout the county including 4 hostels and rent deposit scheme in North Cornwall and Caradon.

We also have a resource centre in Truro which is open for you to call in to have a shower, we will wash you clothes for you, access the food and clothing store, see a resettlement worker, see a doctor or nurse or just to have a warm drink and a chat. If you are a 'big issue' vendor or want to become one then we may be able to help with that aswell.

If you would like further details of the resource centre opening times please feel free to ask one of the team or just turn up. We are normally open between 9.30am and 4.00pm Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and between 12.00noon and 4.00pm on a Tuesday.
